

BUNGALOW SCHEME IN SOLIHULL'S GREEN BELT THROWN OUT

Solihull's planners, in late March, found themselves in the highly unusual position of having to vote again on a scheme they had previously awarded planning permission.

Back in 2017, councillors had approved plans for a four bedroom bungalow to the rear of 27 Lowbrook Lane.

But the decision was later quashed by the High Court, where a judge found that the council had failed to take the harm to the green belt into account.

Having reconsidered the evidence, in light of the Judicial review, Solihull planning officers this time recommended that the application. in the village of Tidbury Green, be thrown out.
